Gateway Opportunities. Students can be arranged placements with worksites in their chosen vocation. The real world learning is assessed by the 'Trade Organisations' (such as BCITO) and students can gain credits. Ms Goldworthy assigns placements for these.

Trade Academy Places are available for students interested in Design, Automotive, Building, Hospitality. These are one day a week full year courses. Typically students will gain between 30-40 credits for these. Ms Goldworthy arranges these at the end of the year for the following year.

Short Courses are available throughout the year where students can gain hands on experience and credits. These are for Primary Industries and Marine Industry. Ms Goldworthy arranges these periodically through the year.
